How to submit your letter to Legislature

You file your letter to the House Committee on Energy & Environment by sending it to this email: hee.exhibits@oregonlegislature.gov

Attach your testimony as either a WORD, PDF, EXCEL or PPT document. Be sure you identify that your “exhibit” pertains to HB 2857 and hearing date of March 26 by clearly referring to HB 2857 and the hearing date in the text of the email.
